



*Arik Kershenbaum*

Dr Arik Kershenbaum researches animal communication at the Department of Zoology, University of Cambridge. He is particularly interested in the communication between cooperative predators, and what this communication tells us about the fundamental principles driving the evolution of language. Dr Kershenbaum's research focusses mostly on wolves, which he studies in Montana, Spain, and Italy, and on free-ranging human-habituated dolphins in the Red Sea. Prior to Cambridge, he was a postdoctoral research fellow at the National Institute for Mathematical and Biological Synthesis (NIMBioS) in Knoxville, Tennessee.
