



**Dr. David Grinspoon** is an astrobiologist, specializing in evolution of climate and habitability on Earth-like planets. He is a Senior Scientist at the Planetary Science Institute. In 2013 he was appointed as the inaugural Chair of Astrobiology at the U.S. Library of Congress where he studied the human impact on Earth and organized a public symposium on the Longevity of Human Civilization. Grinspoon's writing has appeared in the *New York Times*, *Slate*, *Scientific American*, *Boston Globe*, *Washington Post* and the *Los Angeles Times*. His most recent book is *Earth in Human Hands*, an exploration of the Anthropocene Epoch from an astrobiological perspective.

He regards the current human-dominated phase of Earth history as a new type of planetary transition, and applies this perspective to his approach to SETI.
