Fr. José Gabriel Funes, SJ, who is professor at the School of Philosophy in the Catholic University of Cordoba, Argentina, is the former Director of the Vatican Observatory and former member of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences. He studies the scientific, philosophical, and religious implications on the search of other worlds focusing on the anthropological impact of a potential discovery of extra-terrestrial life. He has started the project OTHER (Otros mundos, Tierra, Humanidad, and Espacio Remoto) which is a multidisciplinary think tank. The OTHER team is formed mostly by Argentine researchers of the Catholic University of Cordoba and Universidad Nacional de Córdoba
