



*Lori Marino, Ph.D.*

Lori Marino is a neuroscientist and expert in animal behavior and intelligence, formerly on the faculty of Emory University. She has published over 130 peer-reviewed papers, book chapters, and articles on dolphin and whale (as well as primate and farmed animal) evolution and cognition, comparative brain anatomy, self-awareness in other animals, and human-nonhuman animal relationships. In 2001 she co-authored a ground-breaking study offering the first conclusive evidence for mirror self-recognition in bottlenose dolphins.

From 2000-2004 Lori was a member of the Strategic Planning Committee for the SETI Institute Carl Sagan Center for the Study of Life In the Universe. She is featured in the 2013 documentary *Blackfish*, about orca captivity, and *Unlocking The Cage*, the 2016 film on the *Nonhuman Rights Project*, with which she worked for two years as lead scientist. She is currently president of the Whale Sanctuary Project and executive director of The Kimmela Center for Animal Advocacy.
